- Changes in the Examination pattern of mathematics for the students appearing in class X in March 2020.
 - Two levels of examination will be held.
 - Mathematics – Standard (same as existing one) meant for those who wish to opt mathematics at senior secondary level.
 - Mathematics – Basic (easier level) for those who are not keen to pursue mathematics at higher levels.
 - Students have right to choose between the two levels at the time of enrollment for board examination.
 - In case student fail at any level of mathematics, he/she can appear at the compartment examination as per norms of CBSE given below –

In case of failure	Compartment options
Mathematics - Basic	Mathematics – Basic
Mathematics – Standard	Mathematics – Standard or Mathematics – Basic

- In case, a student changes his/her mind to pursue mathematics at Sr. Secondary level, he/she can appear in Mathematics – Standard at the time of compartment exams as per norms of the board.
